- **Gouache paint set.** Suggested: Winsor & Newton or Holbein primary set, about \$25. Do *not* get "acrylic gouache" which is just matte *acrylic* paint. A cheaper gouache is Arteza although it will be less vibrant and less opaque.
- **Brushes.** Synthetic hair flat, about 3/4 inch, and smaller pointed round.
- **Palette.** White enamel, porcelain, or even a white plastic picnic plate.
- **Paper.** Strathmore 400 series, cold press, about 8 x 10 inches.
Some scrap paper for sketches.
- rags or towel

Dry media:

- Water soluble colored pencils
- Chalk pastels
- 2B graphite pencils
- Erasers

- sharpeners
